As a community we still have many concerns and we need to have these addressed.

Noise and vibration concerns are paramount. We were promised that the number of trains would not increase until construction was finished. Then we get a huge blow at a recent meeting saying that the increase will start next year.

You have told us that the noise mitigation is only for electric trains. What are we supposed to do for the next 10 years with diesel.. which is how many decibels louder?

These are valid concerns that need to be brought to every citizen the 5 mile radius of the tracks - in EVERY community you are going to screw with.

There are still so many that do not know what is going to happen to their neighbourhood. What will the quality of life be if there are diesel trains running outside our windows 36 times a day?
