Parliament Street and Cherry Street Road Closures - Utility Bridge Installations



Overview

Utility relocations have been underway along the rail corridor as part of the enabling work for the GO Expansion OnCorridor Works Project. Above ground utility cables are being replaced with an underground utility duct bank spanning from the Esplanade Transformer Station to Don Yard. Where the duct bank reaches Parliament Street and Cherry Street, the hydro utility cables will be supported by utility bridges that will be installed on the south side of the existing rail bridges.

What is happening?

Proposed date: Weekend of May 25th - 26th: Parliament Street will be closed in both directions between Lake Shore Boulevard E to north of the rail corridor to facilitate the installation of a utility bridge that will be installed on the south side of the rail bridge.

Proposed date: Weekend of June 1st - 2nd: Cherry Street will be closed in both directions between Lake Shore Boulevard E to north of the rail corridor to facilitate the installation of a utility bridge that will be installed on the south side of the rail bridge.



What does this mean for you?

- For safety purposes no access on Parliament Street and sidewalks between Lake Shore Boulevard E to north of the rail bridge on May 25th and 26th (date pending approval)
- For safety purposes no access on Cherry Street and sidewalks between Lake Shore Boulevard E to north of the rail bridge on June 1st and 2nd (date pending approval)

Directional signage will be used to assist pedestrians through this area.

Please note - dates are pending approval and are subject to change. An updated notice will be shared in advance of the work outlining a confirmed date and work hour schedule.
